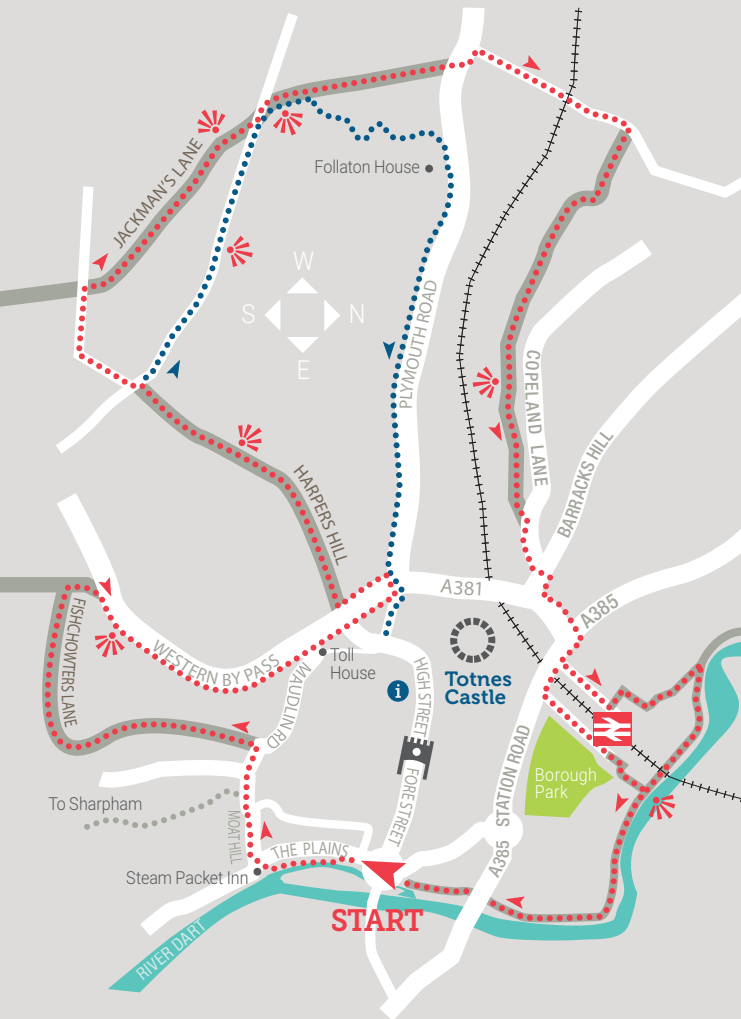


# Franklin Totnes Trail - 6 ¾ mile circular walk

## Franklin Totnes Trail Moderate

6¾ mile/11km round trip

This walk came to life as part of a legacy bequest from Mr. Edward Franklin, a member of the Totnes Ramblers.

Starting on The Plains opposite the **Seven Stars Hotel** you'll head into the leafy countryside which is immediately nestled around the edges of the town centre. Take in sweeping views and significant points of interest including the old Toll House and the more modern and innovative Hydropower Scheme.

The average walker should take 3 to 4 hours to complete this walk but there are options to shorten it along the way. There are several steep ascents and 3 major road crossings along the way.
